The vehicle carries speakers and subwoofers from the said company which has had the Sony sound engineers tuning the nine speakers that was specifically installed and crafted just for the interior of the 2006 Ford Focus. Also top of the line is the Audiophile™ sound system that comprises of the six disc in-dash CD/MP3 player.
