

Car Transport: Tips about Trailers for the Novice

It is natural to feel hesitant about this because you have never employed a car transport before and worry about anything that might go wrong to such a considerable investment as your own car. But this does not have to be a nightmarish experience. A comprehensive basic understanding of how the car transport process works will not only help give you relief from worrying of the problems that may result of such, but also give you the confidence in grabbing the opportunity to make your life easier. This article discusses the common car transport options using trailers, as well as some practical tips for those who are new to availing of car transport services.

There are many options for car transport trailer. The most popular of these options is the open carrier transport. Aside from being widely preferred, the open carrier transport is the least expensive mode of transporting automobiles. Essentially, your car will be transported on haulers, like the ones that are used to deliver new cars. These trailers possess the capacity to hold eight to ten cars. In terms of size, these are about 80 feet long and 14 feet high. The trailer's immense size keeps them limited to traveling on major roads that are free of potential obstacles such as trees and electric posts. The trailer is also restricted from traveling on roads that cannot support its weight, and it cannot easily maneuver on tight turns. The only disadvantage with this mode of car transport is that your automobile may not be amply protected against wear, dust, and the weather, thereby tearing usually associated with highway travel.

The second mode of transporting automobiles is enclosed trailer transport. In contrast to open carrier transport, this by far is the most expensive option. Nevertheless, you get more advantages with this corresponding high cost. Compared to using open carrier transport, your car will more likely be in better shape. That makes this type of transport as the best for cars that are rare, expensive, or expensive cars. Automobiles to be displayed during car shows are usually traveled using this type of transport. It provides the safest, most secure method of auto transport.

The third option is by means of self-transport. Some people prefer to transport their vehicles themselves. This is the most risky way to transport your automobile, especially if you are unskilled in such operations. Usually this is performed by renting a trailer and driving the trailer yourself. If you do choose this type of transport, you may want to learn more about the trailer and its operation. You should ask the owner for instruction and hints on operating such an automobile.

A crucial tip regarding car transport services is being aware of the pick-up time. This is the length of time between the receipt of your order for car transport and the loading of your onto the trailer, ready for actual transport. Typically, pick-up time ranges between 2 and 10 days. Car transport services appreciate a three day allowance to find a trailer and assign your car to that trailer.

The typical transit time will take about 8 to 10 days. Of course, this depends on the destination and the route taken. These trailers will usually load about ten automobiles at a time. Thus, it also makes several necessary stops to deliver each automobile thereby taking up more time. The most reasonable thing to do is to be patient and wait.

Deals such as express service and guaranteed delivery are also available. These offer an added assurance that your car gets delivered to the destination at an earlier time than usual.
